RE: Request to Reclassify Warm Springs Ave (Eckert Road to State Highway 21) to Collector

President May,

The Barber Valley Neighborhood Association (BVNA) appreciates the ACHD Commission's discussion about the reclassification of Warm Springs Ave (Eckert Road to State Highway 21) at the October 12, 2022 Commission Meeting. The Commissioners' candid comments in response to the BVNA's testimony during the open comment portion of the agenda as well as during the Barber Valley Neighborhood Transportation Plan Work Session that followed illustrate the need to address the policy on modifying the ACHD Master Street Map. The Commission's concern and attention also illustrate that this topic is not just a Barber Valley issue, but something that impacts all corners of Ada County.

Per the clarification by ACHD General Counsel at that October 12, 2022 Commission meeting, the BVNA understands that Commissioners may request reclassification of a street as an Action Item on a future ACHD Commission Meeting Agenda. BVNA hereby formally requests that the ACHD Commissioners take action on the BVNA's request to reclassify Warm Springs Ave (Eckert Road to State Highway 21) from an Arterial to a Collector, publicly noticing this as an Action Item on the agenda for the November 9, 2022 ACHD Commission Meeting.
